

# \$1500 Energy Tax Credit



Save now and save later with energy efficient Silver Line Windows. As part of the Economic Stimulus package, the federal tax credit for eligible energy efficient building products, including qualifying windows and doors has been expanded and extended. This offers homeowners a tax credit of up to 30% of the purchase price with a maximum of \$1500, on qualifying products. Products must be purchased and installed from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010.

To be eligible, windows and doors must meet the following requirements:

- a U-Factor equal to or less than 0.30
- a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) equal to or less than 0.30

To qualify for the Tax Credit: \*

- Purchase a qualifying Silver Line window or door with the appropriate options to meet the U-Factor and SHGC requirement of 0.30 or lower. (below is a list of qualifying products)
- Save your sales receipt and NFRC performance label to apply for the tax credit.
- Claim the tax credit associated with your qualifying purchase on your Federal filing for the 2009 and/or 2010 tax year.
- **Note:** The tax credit is for the cost of the product only and does not include installation costs. The tax credit is for 30% of the amount paid for the product up to a maximum of \$1500 combined for 2009 and 2010, including other eligible items listed in the IRS Notice. \*
